Agreement between PPHF and Taaleem Foundation Plan to Upgrade 20 Schools in Mandi Bahawal din

Agreement between Pakistan Public Help Foundation and Taaleem Foundation in Geneva
— Plan to upgrade 20 schools in Mandi bhawal din, Pakistan

An important agreement has been signed between Pakistan Public Help Foundation and Taaleem Foundation, under which 20 government and non-government schools in Pakistan will be upgraded by equipping them with modern facilities. The initial phase of the project will start with 5 schools, the scope of which will be gradually expanded to 20 schools. The signing ceremony was attended by Pakistan Public Help Foundation Chairman Nasir Abbas Tarar and CEO Muhammad Saleem Ahmed Ranjha, while Taaleem Foundation was represented by Chairman Dr. Zafar Iqbal Qadir. Dr. Muhammad Saeed (President of Switzerland Chapter and former Director and International Trade Center), Zaman Mehdi (Pakistani Delegate to UNO), Hussam Cheema (Consul Pakistan Mission to UNO, Geneva) and Tariq Aziz Gujar, a well-known social and business figure from Paris, were also present on the occasion. Taaleem Foundation is a non-profit organization established in 1989 by Dr. Zafar Qadir with the aim of social transformation through education in Balochistan. It is a women-led organization and the largest employer of women in the non-profit sector in Balochistan.

The foundation is working on projects in education, health, technical training, social awareness, cultural heritage conservation, environmental change and technology-based social development. In the education sector, it runs a nationwide network of quality schools and technical training institutions, which provide education and economic opportunities to the youth. The foundation's model is based on community support and public-private partnerships, while USAID, UNESCO, PPL and the federal and provincial governments are its major partners.

Pakistan Public Help Foundation is also a reputable organization working in partnership with local welfare societies in 260 out of a total of 460 villages under its umbrella in Mandi Bahauddin district. Under this new agreement, children from underprivileged areas of Pakistan will have better opportunities for quality education and the foundation for a bright future will be laid.

The process of privatization of educational institutions has begun in Punjab. In the first phase, female schools have been given to the private sector, thus, several thousand female schools in Punjab have gone to the private sector. Giving female schools to the private sector will not put any financial burden on parents, but children will be able to get free education like in government schools. In fact, the practice of getting education in government schools is decreasing day by day, parents try to get their children educated in the best educational institutions, as if in this sense, primary schools were a financial burden for the government. Many primary schools for female students in Rawalpindi district have been given to the private sector. 27 female schools in Gujar Khan tehsil of Rawalpindi will be given to the Taaleem Foundation. Thus, 16 schools in Kotli Satyan tehsil and 6 schools in Rawalpindi will

be managed by the said foundation. The Punjab government will shift the teachers working in the schools that it has given to the private sector to other government schools. However, it is certain that the teachers working in these schools will now have to go to educational institutions far away from their area. This is a good thing. The chairman of the schools that have been entrusted to the Taaleem Foundation, Dr. Zafar Iqbal Qadir, is a righteous former bureaucrat, who created a new history by opening educational institutions of the Taaleem Foundation in a backward province like Balochistan. In 1989, as Deputy Commissioner, he opened the first school of the Taaleem Foundation in Kohlu with the cooperation of Nawab Akbar Khan Bugti. Then, in no time, the scope of the Taaleem Foundation schools spread to the entire Balochistan.
