He called for collective efforts—between civil society, academia, government, and private sector stakeholders—to invest in sustainable digital ecosystems that nurture creativity, critical thinking, and innovation among Pakistan's youth. His remarks resonated strongly with the audience, reinforcing the role of organizations like TF and SACP in shaping a digitally inclusive future where no young person is left behind.

To Whom New Facility Serves ?

The new facility will serve as a multipurpose community complex, integrating, :

- Primary education for children,
- Adult literacy programs
- Vocational training in marketable skills.

The Taaleem Foundation (TF) has forged a landmark partnership with Oil & Gas Development Company Limited (OGDC) through a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) aimed at establishing an eco-friendly school and skills center in Baiker, Phelawagh, District Dera Bugti. With an investment of Rs. 200 million backing this initiative, the focus is on delivering quality education and vocational training to underserved communities in the region. The MoU signing ceremony saw Mr. Ahmed Hayat Lak, MD/CEO of OGDC, and Mr. Asim Mushtaq, CEO of Taaleem Foundation, ink the agreement. Expected to be completed within a year, this project embodies OGDC's vision for advancing education, climate-resilient infrastructure, and sustainable livelihoods, while also reinforcing Taaleem Foundation's mission to empower communities through inclusive learning.

The initiative will place special emphasis on empowering female youth through training in essential skills like sewing, embroidery, and computer literacy. Additionally, awareness workshops on hygiene and nutrition will be conducted to foster holistic well-being in the community. "By launching this initiative, OGDC is not only building infrastructure but also creating pathways to knowledge, skills, and resilience for the underserved communities of Dera Bugti," said Mr. Ahmed Hayat Lak, MD/CEO of OGDC. This flagship initiative marks a significant step by OGDC and Taaleem Foundation towards driving long-term prosperity, promoting gender equity, and building socio-economic resilience in one of Pakistan's most vulnerable regions.
