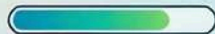

Our Flagship Programs

These flagship programs exemplify Taaleem Foundation's commitment to holistic, inclusive, and sustainable educational development.

TF Grammar School System

TF owns and operates schools in underserved rural and remote regions, ensuring access to quality primary and secondary education for children who might otherwise be deprived of learning opportunities.

Higher Education

TF operates dedicated campuses of Virtual University and NUTECH, expanding access to higher education in remote and underserved areas of Balochistan. These campuses allow students to pursue quality degree programs and technical education without leaving their communities, leveraging digital platforms and modern teaching facilities to bridge regional education gaps.

Teacher Training & Capacity Building

Focused on online professional development, this initiative provides comprehensive training and workshops for teachers to enhance pedagogical skills and keep them updated with the latest educational methodologies.

Gender Mainstreaming

Dedicated to promoting gender equality in education, this program offers scholarships, awareness campaigns, and safe learning environments to support and encourage girls' enrollment and retention in schools.

Inclusive Education Program

This program supports children with special needs at an autism center in Rawalpindi by providing tailored learning materials, teacher training, and community awareness to foster an inclusive educational environment.

EdTech / e-School Solution

TF provides EdTech and e-School services to 70 schools across Pakistan, integrating technology into classrooms. The program equips students and teachers with digital tools, e-learning resources, and AI training to bridge the digital divide in an engaging "learn through play" mode.

TVET Footprint

Aimed at youth and school leavers, this initiative offers vocational training in multiple trades to improve employability and self-reliance. TF operates state-of-the-art technical training centers in Kharan (Balochistan), Sui (Balochistan), a women's skill center in Dera Bugti, a women's skill center in Jahanpur (Multan), and 10 skill centers for Kashmiri women in Muzaffarabad, AJK.

Youth Empowerment for Employment Abroad

TF is an implementation partner of the Government of Balochistan in developing a skilled workforce for overseas employment. To date, 260 skilled workers have been successfully exported, with the number expected to rise to 300 by the end of 2025.

Parent & Community Engagement

Through regular meetings, workshops, and community mobilization, this initiative encourages parental involvement and local ownership of education, ensuring sustainability and responsiveness to community needs.

Health and Hygiene

The TF Health Initiative (TFHI) conducts awareness campaigns and workshops in schools and communities to promote good health, hygiene, and nutrition practices among students and their families.
