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## Our Flagship Programs

These flagship programs exemplify Taaleem Foundation's commitment to holistic, inclusive, and sustainable educational development.

### ◆ **TF Grammar School System:**

TF owns, operates, establishes and manages schools in underserved rural and remote regions, ensuring access to quality primary and secondary education for children who might otherwise be deprived of learning opportunities.

### ◆ **Higher Education**

TF also operates dedicated campuses of Virtual University and NUTECH, expanding access to higher education in remote and underserved areas of Balochistan. These campuses allow students to pursue quality degree programs and technical education without leaving their communities, leveraging digital platforms and modern teaching facilities to bridge regional educational gaps.

### ◆ **Teacher Training & Capacity Building**

Focused on online professional development, this initiative provides comprehensive training and workshops for teachers to enhance their pedagogical skills and keep them updated with the latest educational methodologies.

### ◆ **Gender Mainstreaming**

Dedicated to promoting gender equality in education, this initiative offers scholarships, awareness campaigns, and safe learning environments to support and encourage girls' enrollment and retention in schools.

### ◆ **Inclusive Education Program**

This program supports children with special needs at an autism center in Rawalpindi by providing tailored learning materials, teacher training, and community awareness to foster an inclusive educational environment.

### ◆ **EdTech /e-School Solution:**

TF provides EdTech solution and e-School services to 70 schools across Pakistan. This program integrates technology into the classroom, providing students and teachers with digital tools, e-learning resources, and AI training to bridge the digital divide in 'fun, play and learn' mode.

### ◆ **TVET Footprint**

Aimed at youth and school leavers, this initiative offers vocational training in various trades, helping beneficiaries acquire practical skills for improved employment opportunities and self-reliance. TF operates a state-of-the-art technical training center at Kharan (Balochistan), a custom-built vocational training institute at Sui (Balochistan), a women skill center in Dera Bugti, a women skill center at Jahanpur (Multan) and 10 skill centers for the Kashmiri women in Muzaffarabad, AJK.

### ◆ **Youth Empowerment for Employment Abroad**

TF is an implementation partner of the Government of Balochistan in developing skilled workforce in Balochistan for gainful employment abroad. TF has been able to export 260 skilled workers by now and would have the number raised to 300 by end of 2025.

### ◆ **Parent & Community Engageent**

Through regular meetings, workshops, and community mobilization, this initiative encourages parental involvement and local ownership of education, ensuring sustainability and responsiveness to community needs.

### ◆ **Health and Hygiene**

TF Health Initiative (TFHI) conducts awareness campaigns and workshops in schools and communities to promote good health, hygiene, and nutrition practices among students and their families.
